

NOTICE OF WILDLIFE REGULATION SCHEDULE DETERMINATIONS AND LIMITATIONS

ADAPTIVE MANAGEMENT SHEEP PERMIT NUMBER (2020)

I, John L. Bailey, Deputy Minister of Environment, acting under delegated authority pursuant to the *Wildlife Act* (Section 190) and in accordance with Section 24 and Schedule C, Paragraph 1(a) of the *Wildlife Regulation*, hereby:

- a) Determine that the number of permits for Richardson sheep allocated in Game Management Subzones 1-25 and 1-28 (except Mount Dennis) to be two (2); and
- b) Determine that the number of permits for sheep allocated in Game Management Subzone 5-50 (Pilot Mountain) to be six (6); and
- c) Determine that the number of permits for sheep allocated in Game Management Subzones 7-13, 7-14, 7-16, 7-17, 7-20, 7-21, 7-26 (Arkell) to be sixty (60); and
- d) Determine the number of permits for sheep allocated in Game Management Subzone 7-22 (Primrose) to be twenty-five (25); and
- e) Determine the number of permits for sheep allocated in Game Management Subzone 7-23 (Rose Lake) to be seven (7); and
- f) Determine the number of permits for sheep allocated in Game Management Subzones 7-24, 7-25, 7-27 (Alligator) to be fifteen (15); and
- g) Determine the number of permits for sheep allocated in Game Management Subzones 7-30, 7-31, 7-32 (Skukum) to be thirty-five (35); and
- h) Determine the number of permits for sheep allocated in Game Management Subzone 9-03 (Grey Ridge) to be ten (10).
