**Re: Bringing Yukon's *Wildlife Act* into conformity with the Little Salmon Carmacks First Nation's Final Agreement**

Last summer, the Yukon Fish and Wildlife Management Board (YFWMB) wrote to you requesting that Yukon's *Wildlife Act* be reviewed and modernized to bring it into conformity with the spirit and intent of Yukon First Nations' Agreements.

I am writing this letter to you today to express support for this request from the YFWMB. As noted in their letter, the YFWMB, as well as the Carmacks Renewable Resources Council, are restricted from fulfilling their mandates as defined in our agreements.

In July this year we will celebrate the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the LSCFN Final Agreement. Bringing Yukon's legislation into conformity with our agreements is long overdue. We encourage you to begin this important work of updating Yukon's legislation soon.
